

## Rewards systems suggested

Any teacher can certainly decide to use different types of rewards systems for the students who finish their work or score a specific number of right answers in the assessment provided. In the Teachers' pack you will find three different types of rewards that can be used to encorage students to improve their spelling skills.

The reward systems suggested are a simple way of "gamifying" your spelling activities and are provided as an extra motivational tool. You may decide to have a "classroom store" where students can buy stuff with their stickers, a classroom poster where students can compare their achievement or just a badges folder where each student can put together all the rewards obtained to take home and make their parents proud of their progress.

## Badges, Certificates, Stickers

Our "Dojo" metaphor is one of the ways we provide for you to reward your students with "badges". There are four levels for each "Ninja" / student in your "Dojo" / classroom: Legendary Master (four Dojo stickers), Sensei Ninja (three Dojo stickers), Intermediate Ninja (two Dojo stickers), Novide Ninja (one Dojo sticker).

You are the one who decides where the boundaries are for each award.

If you do not like the "Dojo" wording, you can use the Certificates. There are four levels as well, each representing a maximum of four stickers for your students, according to their mastery levels.

With each reward you can provide the matching number of stickers for your students so they also have a "trading coin" or simply a way to collect the maximum number of stickers and beat the rest of the class with them.
